

Summer Programs 2016

(8 day program for concurrent Composition I students)

Dates: June 23 - 30, 2016

Location: University of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR)

Population: Any 10th-12th grade students who are currently enrolled in college composition. This will conclude their Composition I class during the first four days (6/23-6/26). These students will then begin Composition II the last four days (6/26-6/30). Both of these classes are hybrid models which will allow students to complete the required hours through a mixture of in-class meetings and online assignments.

*(4 day program for first-time participants and previous participants who have not tested into college classes yet) * Upcoming 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students only **

Dates: June 26 - 30, 2016

Location: UALR

Population: Any student who is a first-time or previous participant and will be in the 10th, 11th, or 12th grade beginning August 2016.

*(3-week program for graduated seniors) *First-time and previous participants**

Dates: July 10 - 30, 2016

Location: UALR and Philander Smith College

Population: All graduated seniors that have been accepted to the program will attend this program. Some students will work to bypass developmental classes, while others may begin Composition II and College Algebra, depending on their test scores. Students who complete the 3-week program are eligible for the CWDSA scholarship to either UALR or Philander Smith College.
